Double Header vs. Double Qualifier

Double Header:

Is a one day event with two (2) shows. Producers pay two sanctioning fees, plus \$1.00 per runner in the Open.

Double Qualifier:

Is one run that allows our members to obtain two (2) qualifications while competing in one show. Both producers and members benefit from this type of show. Producers pay one sanctioning fee, plus \$1.00 per runner in the Open.

Each State Director has one "double qualification" to give in a calendar year. The State Director will select which show in their state they want to give it to. The NWBRA prefers a larger show with added money. If you feel your show meets this criteria, please reach out to your State Director.
